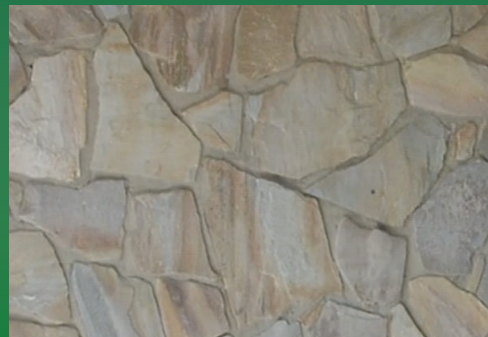

GOAL REMOVE PAINT

Since this was an indoor project, it was important to contain the abrasive and removed paint.

The Dustless Blasting system suppresses most airborne dust, but plastic was put up to protect the floor and drywall from moisture. For this reason, the setup and cleanup time was longer than most outdoor projects.
