

Safety Checklist (BEFORE YOU DRIVE AWAY)

- ☐ Trailer is evenly loaded.
- ☐ If carrying a pallet of media in the back of the trailer, the water tank should always be filled to evenly distribute weight.
- □ Toolboxes are latched and secured.
- □ Compressor canopy is lowered and secured.
- □ Loose objects are secured down with ratchet straps.
- ☐ Fill funnel and accessories are put away.
- ☐ Hoses are coiled and secured.



Trailer Hookup Procedures

- 1. With the winding crank, lower the trailer onto the 2 $\frac{5}{16}$ " ball hitch until the foot is *just* off the ground.
- 2. Ensure the hitch is latched, and safety pin behind the collar is installed.
- 3. On the foot, remove the pin, raise the drop foot, and pin it again at the highest setting.
- 4. Retract foot the rest of the way with the winding crank.
- 5. Hook up safety chains, crossing them to make a cradle.
- 6. Pull emergency brake clip out of its box.
- 7. Loop the emergency brake clip through the safety chain receiver.
- 8. Run this wire through the safety pin on the hitch, to prevent slack from dragging on the ground.
- 9. Plug the brake clip back into the its box.
- 10. Plug in lights and make sure they work.
